
Report:




INDUCTION WEEK:





- 4. In our verification of student fees ledgers, we observed following income of earlier years received in current year amounting to ₹29.89 lakhs received from scholarship department were recorded under income.

- Further to above college has recognised Examination grant of ₹2.59 lakhs as an indirect income. In our opinion college should recognize income as revenue or capital as per its nature.
- Written policy document for student fees receipts of in instalments and process of recovery of outstanding fees were not found on record.

Other Income

 Amount received for sale of admission form, sale of scrap, exam form fees etc. Included in the miscellaneous receipts ledger which is an incorrect accounting since GST Act is applicable to college hence, needs to create separate ledger for each based upon nature of receipts and again in to taxable and non-taxable.

Risk/Impact

- Risk of loss of revenue loss if there are reconciliation differences in data maintained
- Loss of Bank Interest if not collected by college within due date.
- Risk of accumulation of more outstanding fees from year to year basis.
- Non recovery of O/s fees might face problem for monthly working capital gap and also Risk of Bad Debts.
- Improper classification may distort position of income earned.

Recommendations

- We recommend college to prepare and implement written policy regarding collection of O/s student fees.
- It is recommended that college would have to formulate policies to collect outstanding.
 Fees within due date and also depute separate person to recover O/S Fees from students.

- There is a difference of ₹52,488/- in opening balance of HDFC Bank a/c no- 89692
 - a. Opening balance as per final balance sheet –₹ 19,32,126.64
 - b. Opening balance as per books ₹18,79,638.64
- Saving bank interest from bank of Maharashtra (Exam) a/c no 93982 of ₹ 10,367/- dated 06th April, 20 shown under university examination grant instead of bank interest income (corrected by concerned person during our audit)
- There is a difference in bank reconciliation of HDFC bank in the month of June-20, which was corrected by concerned person during our audit.
- Comparative statement of innovative interior is not available with other suppliers for our verification.
- Payment made to audit fees to Krishna Rawas & Associates but invoice not found or not available at the time of audit.
- Some invoices submitted to college for payments were found in the name of Marathwada Mitra Mandal (trust) instead of college name.
- 7. In our analysis of average monthly bank balance from April 20 to Dec 20 we observed huge closing bank balances than required for their operational expenses. We observed college has not taken auto swipe facility for transfer of excess receipts to trust account. We observed lacunas in all 3 banks HDFC -account BOI account and BOM account inspite of appropriate communication from Top management for transferring of excess fees amount to MM Mandal account.
- We observed that college having Exam account in bank of Maharashtra however we didn't observe any payments related with conducting of exams or any any other exam related payments.
- Bank account opened for expenses related to NASA Fees. Same bank account not shown in books of accounts of college since it used by staff and students. Required to check KYC of bank account (i.e. PAN) for verification of Mandal PAN or other staff member PAN given or not.

Risk/Impact

a. Improper data entry in tally system

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b. Chances of loss of bank interest in excess cash balance lying in bank a/c.

Recommendations

- We suggest college should have to record all accounting transactions under appropriate accounting head.
- b. We suggest that college should have to find concrete solution for investing excess amount under various bank deposit or alternative investment scheme. Also college may transfer excess bank balance to MM Mandal A/c for alternative investment.

3. SCRUTINY OF ACCOUNTING LEDGER, BALANCES ETC.

Audit of scrutiny of Accounting Transactions, Ledgers and Balances - Liabilities

Audit Observations

- In our verification of opening balances we found opening difference of ₹ 4,186/- in college balance sheet as on the date of audit.
- We found that amount of ₹3.60 lakhs having credit balance posted as suspense entry in suspense ledger.
- College has wrongly classified Some of the sundry creditors under sundry debtors. i.e..
 Anand kulkarni, Lunkad Fabrics, Suvidha Hospitality Pune. It is advised to check the nature of relation and classify accordingly.
- 4. We observed that opening debit balance of ₹37,999/- were observed for which proper invoice were not received by college up to the date of our audit. According to our understanding the same showing debit balance from last 3 year.
- It is our opinion that college should have to reconcile following deposit accounts which has opening balances from so many years and transfer or merge with other ledgers

Audit of scrutiny of Accounting Transactions, Ledgers and Balances - Assets

Audit Observations

- Income & expenditure a/c opening balance of ₹ 4,93,39,287.44 Dr. Showing under current assets instead of showing as opening balance of income & expenditure a/c separately. (it was corrected by concerned person during our audit)
- It is our opinion that college should have to reconcile following deposit accounts which has opening balances from so many years and transfer or merge with other ledgers

In our inquiry with concerned person he has explained that all these are opening advances and all above mentioned person has already left the college hence we are unable to trace the them.

- Credit balance of ₹ 1,545/- were observed in sundry debtors account for which appropriate
 action were not taken by concerned person.
- Inter institutional balances between college and MM Mandal were not tallied up to the date of our audit.
- Deposit with Council of architecture classifies as a deposit instead of classifying it as an investment.

Audit of scrutiny of Accounting Transactions, Ledgers and Balances - Expenses

Audit Observations

- Quick heal license taken for 3 year but the college has recognised whole expenses in current year only instead of differing for next 2 years on proportionally showing as postpaid expenses.
- In verification of repairs & maintenance expenses we found that most of the expenses are related to building hence need to capitalize instead of debiting to PLA.
- Lacunas were observed in the accounting of university exam grant, we found that sometimes it is shown as net of expenses and sometimes shown separately as an income.
- University exam fees received from student of ₹2,115/- show as university examination grant which is incorrect
- Grade Pay (GP) of Non-teaching for Nov.2020 month wrongly booked in AGP (T) ledger (corrected by concerned person during our audit)
- 6. We found that college has made payment of ₹25,170/- to council of architecture related to following invoices, which are pertaining to various gift item given earlier as gift to college, but now they raised the invoices and college has made the payment however earlier invoices were unavailable with college.

4. AUDIT OF STATUTORY LIABILITIES VIZ. TDS, GST, PT, PF etc.

Audit of TDS Viz. Form No. 24Q & 26Q

Audit Observations

- There is short deduction of TDS in case of 'Innovative Interiors' and also TDS deduction rate is also not maintained uniform for TDS deduction. College uses the rate 2%, 1.35%, 0.75% & 0.89%.
- TDS deducted of the previous month invoice in the current month invoice but no interest is paid on late deduction of TDS in the case of M/s Rhythm Communications 27,258 @ 1.5% invoice dated 02/11/2020 TDS deducted on 31/12/2020.
- 3. TDS not deducted on internet installation charges of Rs. 15,000/- on dated 09/09/2020
- TDS not deducted on housekeeping charges paid to Unique security services and labour suppliers on invoice dated 10/09/2020 amounting Rs. 9,500/-
- 5. There is a difference in TDS deduction and TDS payment on monthly basis on Contractor payments

- TDS deducted & recorded @ 10% instead of 7.5% in case of Mundhe Shaha & Co. Dated 10/11/2020 however payment were correctly made to party at lower rate. We advise to correct wrong amount of entry made in the books of accounts.
- TDS of ₹ 9,230/- not deducted and paid on payment made to <u>Dimakh Consultants Pvt. Ltd.</u> dated 31st May 2018.
- Defaults of ₹ 6,84,410/- for Form No 24Q and for Form No 26Q has been found on the name of college for the FY 2007-08 to FY 2013-14.

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 Unconsumed challan of ₹ 58,106/- under various section paid to Government by college from FY 2007-08 to FY 2013-14 has not been consumed up to the date of audit.

Audit of Profession Tax

Audit Observations

In our review of PT we found that there were differences in deduction and payment of profession Tax on monthly basis

Audit of Provident fund

Audit Observations

Employer's share of EPF Rs. 3,89,778/- were not booked as an expenses in the books currently it is posted under current liabilities and provisions which is incorrect.

Audit of GST

Audit Observations

- GST paid for the month of Oct-20 & Nov.-20 wrongly recorded under Mundhe Shaha & co. ledger which needs rectification by transferring to GST Payable ledger.
- 2. Following input GST were wrongly transferred to another ledger viz.
 - Input GST of ₹ 9,792/- dated 07/07/2020 transfer by accountant to creditors ledger (Creative sales corporation) instead of furniture & fixture ledger.
 - Input GST of ₹ 508.20/- dated 08/05/2020 transfer by accountant to creditors ledger (Kamdhenu Xerox & Stationery) instead of Printing & Stationery ledger.

Mundhe Shaha & Co Chartered Accountants



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- Month wise GSTR 2A reconciliation statement were not prepared and found on record up to the date of audit.
- Following system generated documents (from tally software) were not found on record up to the date of audit for our verification and vouching;
 - o Month-wise Tax invoices for taxable from April, 20
 - o Month-wise Bill of Supply for exempt supply from April, 20
 - Month-wise payment vouchers and tax invoices for RcM supplies received U/s 9(3) of the GST Act, 2017.

Recommendations

It is suggested to automate auto generation of above type of documents through tally system.
